

SPRING CLASSES

Here's a list of Spring classes, beginning Sunday, **February 26th**, at **8:15AM** right before our 9:30AM worship service. Most classes run for 12 weeks. Two classes are only 5 weeks (the 2nd 5-week class begins in April). Childcare will be provided for children age 2 through 5th grade.

Jumpstart: Basics of the Christian Life (5 Weeks). “How do I live as a Christian?” This short, 5-week class is meant to function as a “jump start” for the Christian life. It answers the basic question of what it means to be a Christian and how we should live. This a great class for anyone new to the Christian faith, still considering Christianity, or if you simply feel like you've been plodding along and you need a jumpstart in your walk with Christ.

Decision-making and God's Will (5 Weeks). Do you get anxious when you need to make decisions that will influence your life? This 5-week class will explore how God wants us to make decisions, how to discern God's will, and ultimately how to rest in God's care for us. THIS CLASS WILL BEGIN ON SUNDAY, APRIL 2nd.

New Testament Survey, Part 2. This class gives an overview of the NT from the Paul's Letters to John's letters and Revelation focusing on the authorship, genre, style, theme and message of each of these biblical books. This is great for any Christian desiring to grow in their understanding of God's word and how each book of the bible has a unique contribution to the whole. You don't need to have Part 1 to attend!

Marriage. Marriage is one of the most important human institutions in the world. So then, why is it so hard!? And if marriage wasn't hard enough already, it has come under serious attack in the public square. This class will first help ground us in a biblical understanding of God's design for marriage and then give practical helps to deal with issues like communication, conflict, sex, children, finances and more.

Hebrews. The letter to the Hebrews is considered by many to be one of the more difficult books of the bible. At the same time, it is one of the richest; it is saturated with Old Testament references and regularly paints an extraordinary picture of Christ. This class will walk through the book of Hebrews exploring its theme and message, so that students will better be able to persevere in their walk with Christ.

MIDDLE SCHOOL/HIGH SCHOOL:

Student Class: Old Testament Survey, Part 2. This class gives an overview of the OT from the Psalms to Malachi, focusing on the authorship, genre, style, themes and message of each of these books. This is great for growing in your overall understanding of God's word, and how each book of the bible uniquely contributes to the whole.
