

# FALL CLASSES 2017

Here's a list of Fall classes, beginning Sunday, September 24th. Classes begin at either 8:15 AM or 11:15 AM and vary from 5 weeks to 12 weeks. Childcare for all ages will be offered during the 11:15 AM Sunday School hour.

## 8:15 AM

***God's Story (9 Weeks).*** The Bible tells one unified story. If you want to have an understanding of God's plan for the world, you need to be able to follow the storyline of the Bible. If you've never taken a class or are unfamiliar with the message of the whole Bible, this is a great place to be established in God's word.

*Class will be taught by Matt Hagemann in Room B74/77 off of the commons.*

***Knowing God Better (12 Weeks).*** Do you know what God is like? Do you want to know God better and more personally? This class will equip you to do that by exploring God's attributes and how knowing God through his word impacts your life.

## 11:15 AM

***Jumpstart: Basics of the Christian Life (5 Weeks).*** "What does it mean to be a Christian?" This short, 5-week class is meant to function as a "jump start" to help you establish you in the Christian faith. This a great class for anyone new to the Christian faith, still considering Christianity, or if you simply feel like you've been plodding along and you need a jumpstart in your walk with Christ.

*Class will be taught by John Brewer in Room A36, down the hall to the right of the sanctuary.*

***Living as a Christian: Basics of Christian Character (7 weeks).*** This class picks up where Jumpstart leaves off (though you don't need to take Jumpstart first!). As Christians, our character is being formed to be like Christ's. This short, 7-week class is designed to establish you in the basics of Christian Character.

***The Church: How God Gathers His People (5 weeks).*** Many people claim to love Jesus, but not the church. Is that a valid option for us? How does God feel about the church as a whole? What about local churches like ours? How should churches relate to one another? What place should the church have in your Christian life? Join us as we consider the church together -- a topic that will inevitably shape every Christian's life and ministry.

*Class will be taught by Danny D'Acquisto in Room A33, down the hall to the right of the sanctuary.*

***What Jesus says to the Church: A study on Revelation 1-3 (7 weeks).*** In the opening chapters of the book of Revelation Jesus has some very specific words for seven different churches. This class will spend seven weeks looking at what Jesus says to these churches, while also gaining some understanding about how to read the challenging book of Revelation.

*Class will be taught by Nick Ringger in Room B74/77 off of the commons.*

***Last Things: Understanding what the Bible says about "end times" (5 weeks).*** The Bible tells us that right now Jesus is ruling and reigning from his throne in heaven, but one day he will return. This class will explore the series events surrounding the return of Christ as he finally gathers his people and makes everything new.

***STUDENT CLASS: New Testament Survey, Part 1 (12 Weeks).*** This class gives an overview of the New Testament from the gospels to the letters of Paul, focusing on the authorship, genre, style, theme and message of each of these biblical books.

*This class is for students - those in middle school and high school. Class will be taught by Chris Amundson and Clint Klepp in the A35, down the hall to the right of the sanctuary.*
