SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this week's text, the Preacher walks through the complex relationship between wisdom and folly. While wisdom is far better than the strength and shouting of fools even a little folly can also do so much damage to what is good. This is advice that people of all stages of life would do well to heed.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Last week, the Preacher spoke about the inevitably and unpredictability of death for all. How are we to live in light of these things?
- 2. In 9:13-16, the Preacher tells a story as an illustration. What is the lesson that he is giving? What are some examples of how this advice plays out in real life?
- 3. In 9:18 he tells us that "Wisdom is better than weapons of war, but one sinner destroys much good? Where have you experienced this truth in your own life? How do we walk with care, knowing that one act of foolishness can destroy so much?
- 4. Verses 10:16-19 talks about how the way a king composes himself has an effect on the land he rules. How have we seen this through history? How ought this affect the way that we pray for our leadership?
- 5. In 10:20, we are further instructed on how we should act (and even think) as it pertains to civic leadership. How does this challenge you personally?
- 6. How does knowing and following Jesus give us the freedom to live in accordance with the wisdom presented here in this passage?
