SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this final week of our series on the local church, we look at the idea of membership. We highly value church membership here at Grace, but what about it makes it so important? In the sermon this week, Pastor Mike drew out the principles of church membership from Philippians 3 and showed us that our relationship and responsibility to each other is deeper and more profound than we probably thought.

Discussion Questions

1. As we now conclude this current series, what stands out to you as an area of needed personal growth in relation to your participation in the church? What steps forward do you plan to take?
2. Do we view church membership the same way that we view other types of membership (Costco, country club, etc.)? If so, what problems does this pose in how we interact with the church?
3. Read Philippians 3:8-15. What is meant by the word 'share' in verse 10? How does a fuller understanding of this word give us a better picture of our relationship to one another?
4. Who are to be considered members? What makes it so important to draw distinctions between who can be members and who can't?
5. What benefit is it to us to be a member of the local body? What is it that we do for one another?
6. As we talk about pressing forward as a church into the new year, what is it that you hope we accomplish together? Do you feel locked in with Grace in doing your part to meet the goals that have been set forward during this series?
