SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

We are now into the second week of our month-long series on the local church. This is a chance for us to take a step back and think through our life as a local body in a biblical, yet practical and strategic manner. This Sunday, Pastor Mike walked us through what this looks like in the area of stewardship. What we have been given and the way we use it is an essential part of our lives as followers of Christ.

Discussion Questions

1. Why is it important for us to take some time and go through a series like this as a church? Have you personally found it encouraging/challenging?
2. Psalm 24:1 tells us that 'the earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof,..'. What is this telling us about God? How does this affect the way we think about the things we possess?
3. How is understanding God's graciousness in giving to us connected with our giving? Do you feel that this connection gets lost on you sometimes?
4. What does it practically look like in our lives to hold an open hand with our treasure? Our talent? Our time?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 16:1-2. What does this teach us about the nature of a Christian's giving? Why do you think we are often quick to take offense when we discuss these things?
6. How does the nature of our giving express the gospel message to each other and the watching world?
