

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this week's passage, we find ourselves at a break in the action. The opening of the seven seals gave way to seven trumpets. The first six trumpets have been blown, bringing about the judgments of God upon the earth and the hardened hearts of those who refuse to repent. Now, before the seventh trumpet is blown, just as we saw before the seventh seal was opened, John is shown something special. Before the seventh seal he saw the great multitude of those who worship the Lamb. Now before the seventh trumpet and final judgment, John sees a mighty angel come down from heaven with a scroll. And on this scroll would be a sweet and bitter message for all peoples, nations, languages, and kings.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Have you ever had to deliver good news and bad news at the same time? How did it make you feel?
- 2. Describe the relationship between the mighty angel, the voice from heaven, and John. What do you notice about the way these characters interact with one another, and how does that help you understand the passage?
- 3. What is the "mystery of God" mentioned in verse 7? Read Ephesians 1:9-10 to help guide your thinking on this.
- 4. In the end of the passage, John is told to eat the scroll and then prophesy to the nations. This is similar to the command given to the prophet in Ezekiel 2-3. What is the purpose of the prophet and their prophesy? How does Romans 16:25-27 speak to this?
- 5. What does this passage mean for us today? What is our role in making known the mystery of God?
