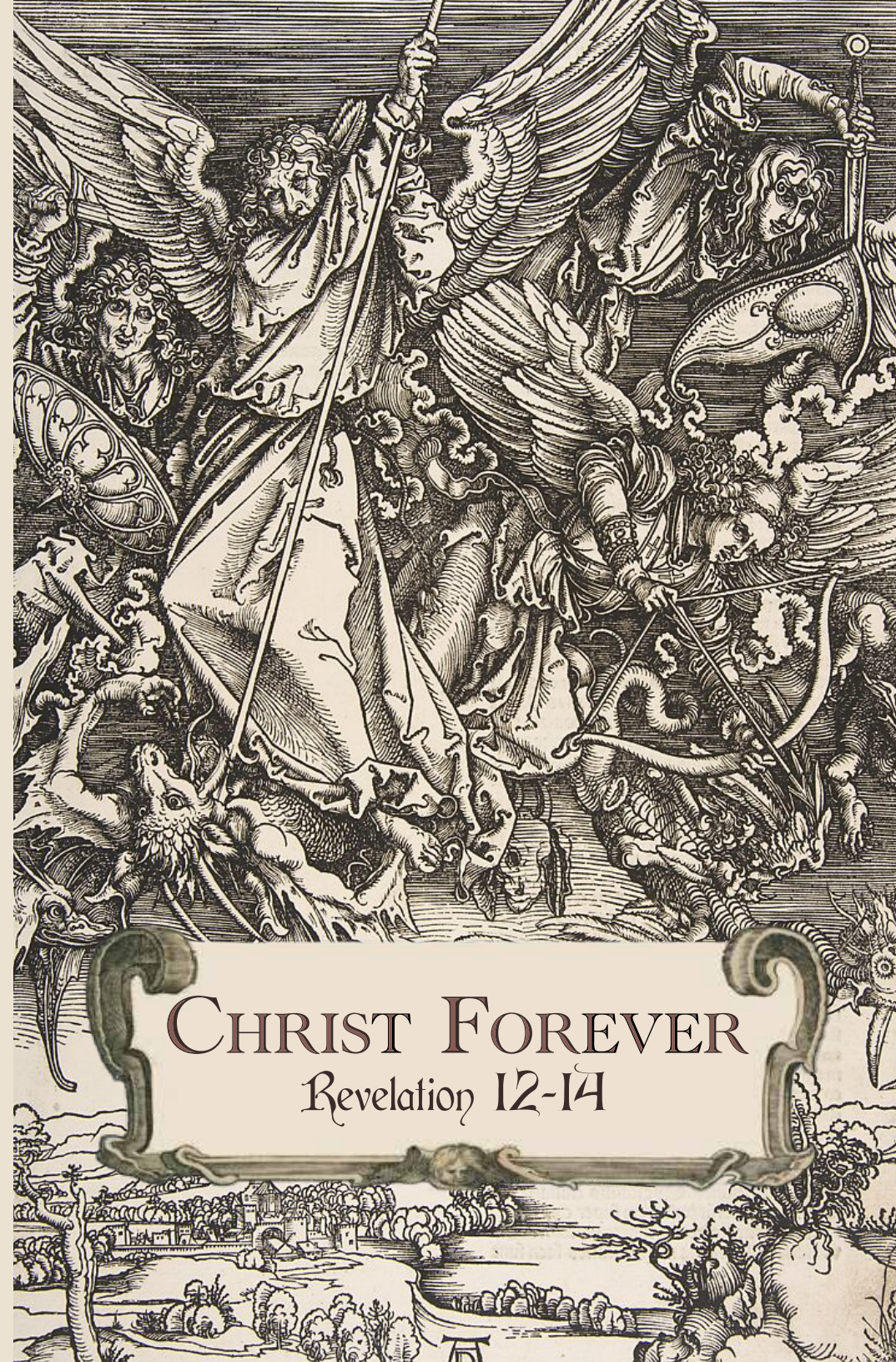

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

Last week in Chapter 12, we saw the dragon, Satan himself, thrown down from heaven and begin his great war on those who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Now in chapter 13, John sees the infamous beast rise from the sea. There is a lot of confusion about this beast. But if we read carefully, we can come away with a clear sense of what God is revealing to us about the nature of evil and the hope we have in enduring and faithfully following Christ to the very end.

Discussion Questions

1. What is the scariest dream you've ever had? What made it so scary, and what hope did you have when you woke up?
2. We are told in verse 2 that the beast (the rulers/governments of this world based on Daniel 7) is given his power and authority from the dragon (i.e. Satan). How does the beast use this evil power? What is the response from the people of the world?
3. Read verses 5-7. What does the beast say? What does the beast do? Who does it say allowed this? Why is that significant?
4. Who are the ones who won't worship the beast? What is it about them that protects them from worshipping the beast?
5. "If anyone is to be taken captive, to captivity he goes." This means that everyone's fate is sealed. Those who will worship the beast will worship the beast and those who won't, won't. Why is this good news for you? And how does this give you faith to endure till the end?
