

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week we finally come to the seventh trumpet. Like the seventh seal that was opened in chapter 8, this final trumpet blast serves to symbolize the end of God's judgment and the beginning of the new order of God's kingdom. Verse 15 sums this up when it says, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever." That describes the fulfillment of God's redemptive plan for all creation, a plan where heaven and earth would be united as one kingdom under God. As you reflect on this passage this week, consider how that end goal of unification between heaven and earth might affect the way you live your life today.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What is your favorite "happy ending" in a movie or book you've read? What was it about that ending that was so satisfying?
- 2. When the seventh trumpet blows nothing actually is described to have happened, it is merely stated by voices in heaven and twenty four elders. Why do you think that is? What does it tell us about the importance of our response to God's glorious work?
- 3. In verse 18, the elders speak of the reward for the saints and the judgment of the dead. Read the Parable of the Tenants in Matthew 21:33-44. What is the punishment and what is the reward?
- 4. In this passage we're told that the temple is opened and the ark of the covenant is seen. This is remarkable because the ark of the covenant was only ever seen once a year by the high priest on the Day of Atonement (Leviticus 16). Remember this is highly symbolic language, so what does it mean and why does it matter?
- 5. 2 John 1:8 says, "Watch yourselves, so that you may not lose what we have worked for, but may win a full reward." How might you watch yourself so that on that day of judgment you might "win a full reward"?
