

# **SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

After a mountain-top vision from the text last week, John now gives a startlingly dark description of what awaits those who reject the living God and worship the beast. This week's passage contains probably the most explicit reference to the nature of God's wrath in all of the scriptures and so it is rightfully met with a sense of trembling. But ultimately, this is a word to encourage the saints to endure all the more.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Read 14:1-5 again. Review what last week's passage was about and discuss how it informs our understanding of this week's text.
- 2. The first angel proclaims an eternal gospel to all of those who dwell on the earth. Why is it called an "eternal gospel". Why do you think John uses this particular phrase versus just saying "the gospel" like everywhere else in scripture?
- 3. The second angel speaks of the falling of "Babylon the great". How does biblical history inform our understanding of what is meant here? How do we see 'Babylon' at work today?
- 4. The third angel delivers the message of the eternal conscious torment that is set aside for those who worship the beast. What is your gut reaction to hearing this passage? Why must we hold tight to the truth of these words even though we may be tempted to ignore them or rationalize them away?
- 5. This whole passage is meant to encourage us to endure. How does it function that way? Does it encourage you to faithfulness?
- 6. What does this text tell us about Jesus? How might it affect the way that we talk about or share the gospel with others?
