SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

Last week, we got a vision of a prostitute riding the beast. In chapter 18, John is made privy to a detailed word on what will truly become of her. This is a passage that continues to show us what the final judgment of all things will look like. Babylon is fallen. And with it, we see a very sharp contrast in the reaction to this news; depending on the perspective it comes from.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Last week we were introduced to the woman, Babylon. What does she represent in the physical world? What does it look like for us today?
- 2. The first angel in chapter 18 announces Babylon's falling. From the imagery that is used to describe her in vs. 2-4, what was she like and what has she become?
- 3. Another voice begins in verse 4 and immediately commands God's people to 'Come out of her,...' What does it look like practically for us to obey this command? Why are the stakes for us obeying this command so high?
- 4. Discuss, the reaction of the kings of the earth, the merchants, and seafarers in vs. 9-19. What was the reputation of Babylon as far as they were concerned? What fact keeps getting repeated here that clearly amazes all of them?
- 5. The last 'mighty angel' throws a millstone in the sea and speaks in 21-24. What is the main idea about Babylon that he is communicating to the reader? What should our reaction/response be to this news?
- 6. How does a passage like this point people to the Gospel of Jesus Christ? How could the things expressed in Revelation 18 be used in sharing the gospel with others?


