SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

The beginning of Revelation 19 presents to us a view from heaven of the celebration over God's judgment of Babylon. This is followed up with an announcement of a marriage feast to happen soon. This text shows us that a new reality is upon us. The old is passing away and the new is about to come. The goodness of this news is dependent on the object of a person's worship.

Discussion Questions

- 1. A major theme from the text last week (chap.18) was that Babylon, in all her glory, fell unexpectedly in such a short amount of time. How does knowing this affect the way you view and interact with the things of this world? What things do you still need to repent of?
- 2. Once again, the beginning of chapter 19 opens up with the multitudes and heavenly beings praising God for his judgment on the world. How has this repeated theme in these last few chapters (and in much of the whole book of Revelation) changed the way you view God and his judgment?
- 3. Verse 2 gives us the reason behind God's destruction of Babylon: Vengeance. Why is vengeance almost always rightly viewed as a bad thing, but it's a good thing here?
- 4. In verses 6-9 we have an announcement of a marriage to happen soon. Who is the Bride and how is her description completely different than the prostitute from chapter 17?
- 5. After the angel corrects John for worshiping him, an interesting statement is made at the end, "..the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." What does this mean and why is it placed here?
- 6. What does the coming marriage supper have to do with the gospel message? How does it add to our understanding of the good news?



MISSION MOMENT

Julio & Olga Chiang



Julio and Olga Chiang are Grace supported field workers serving as church planters in Peru with South America Mission (SAM). Julio is a Peruvian national pastor who is also a former professional champion motocross racer. He was in a serious motorcycle accident two weeks ago resulting in a broken clavicle and 7 fractured ribs. He underwent surgery to repair the clavicle. He was released from ICU and has begun the long road to recovery.
