SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In Chapter 16, the hour of judgment has come. And the image in which we see it here is with seven angels pouring out the seven bowls of God's wrath. Each bowl seemingly more intense than the last. But its in the contrasting responses over these things from heaven and on earth where we truly see the difference between those who stand with the Lord. and those who stand against him.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Last week, we entered into a new mini-series in Revelation (15-20) where the imagery is repeatedly focused on the final judgment. Why do you think God sees fit to spend so much time drawing our attention to the same subject?
- 2. Verse 1 shows us that all that is done to those who dwell on the earth in judgment is done by divine decree (God's command). Why is this important to know? Why is this good news for those who believe?
- 3. After the third bowl is poured out, the angel over the waters sing out about the justice of God. How are these judgments a fitting punishment to the crime committed?
- 4. The intensity of the final four bowls reaches a fever pitch and yet the response of the people is to curse God and refuse to repent. What does this tell us about the reality of human nature and unbelief?
- 5. An odd statement is made in the middle of what is described after the sixth bowl (vs. 15). What does this mean and what does it look like for us to abide by it?
- 6. One of the most striking features of this passage is that people refuse to worship God despite a clear demonstration of his power and authority. How does a text like this lead us to the gospel; as unlikely as that may seem at first glance? What does this say about the nature of divine grace in reflecting on your own salvation?
