SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

Last week, we saw Satan defeated and thrown into the Lake of Fire. Now, we come to the last enemy of God and His people: Death. From upon His great white throne judgment is poured out upon “the dead” and ultimately upon Death itself. Though the punishment of an eternity spent in a Lake of Fire is a terrible reality to face, in this latter part of [Revelation 20](#) we see that the One who sits on this throne is indeed holy, just, and true in His judgments.

Discussion Questions

1. When you think of hell, what mental pictures come to mind? What feelings arise in your heart when you think about people facing God’s eternal judgment? What do these thoughts and feelings reflect about your own understanding of who God is?
2. Who is this judge on the throne? How is this scene described in verse 11? What do these descriptions convey about the character of the one who is seated on the throne?
3. Who are “the dead” in this passage? What clues from the rest of chapter 20 lead you to this conclusion? Why is “dead” an appropriate description of these people? (See Ephesians 2:1-3 for better understanding)
4. Read verse 12. By what evidence are the dead being judged? How would you feel if a book was opened and every thought, word, and action you ever had was bared before God? Why is it just and right for a holy God to judge the dead based on this evidence? Why is it also just and right that those who were raised in the first resurrection do not have this evidence held against them?
5. Is your name written in the Book of Life? How do you know? If you are certain that your name is written there, spend some time in prayer thanking Jesus for taking the punishment you deserve and asking Him to give you opportunities and boldness to share the Gospel with those who are still currently lost. If you are unsure of your answer, what are some next steps you can take this week to ensure that you are not one of “the dead”? Read 2 Peter 3:10-13. How should the coming sure judgment of the Lord affect your life this week?

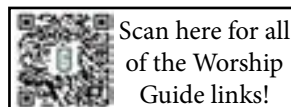
