

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In the wrapping up of Revelation (and history as we know it), we are treated to an abundance of imagery that gives us a glorious peek at our lives to come. We will finally be with our God forever in the place that he has prepared for us. One interesting aspect of this week's passage is how it shows us that the new heavens and the new earth are not completely different from the world we see today, but it is a renewed and far better version of it.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Last week's text (21:9-21) focused on the bride at the consummation of all things. How is she described and what does each description mean?
- 2. John sees no temple in the new city. What does the temple represent throughout scripture and what makes what John does see in its place so significant?
- 3. What do you suppose it means that 'the kings of the earth will bring into it the glory and the honor of the nations'?
- 4. As you think about biblical history; especially from early events in Genesis, why is it so significant that the nations are worshiping God and the Lamb?
- 5. Compare and contrast the imagery that we see in 22:1-5 with that of the Garden of Eden. What does all of this tell us about the nature of the new heavens and the new earth?
- 6. Consider our world as it is now and the passage this week. How does this week's passage speak to the gospel needs of your unbelieving neighbor?
