SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week, we looked at the first section of verses in chapter 5. And while most of Ecclesiastes up to this point has been a series of observations about the visible world, the Preacher's approach changes toward giving advice in this passage. His concern is the careless usage of words before God and the dangers inherent to it. It is a text that exposes the connection between the words of our mouth and our heart's attitude toward God.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Last week was about the need for community and the vanity of living life in isolation. Where do you need to grow when it comes to relationships with others in the church? What steps can you take?
- 2. 'Guard your steps when you go to the house of God'. What does the Preacher mean by this and what does the 'house of God' refer to (for the original readers and for us)?
- 3. What does it look like to be hasty with our words before God? In what particular ways do you think you have been guilty of it?
- 4. Verses 4-6 talk about vows. What does making flippant vows to God look like for us and how do we apply what the Preacher is prescribing here?
- 5. Read verse 7. What do you think he means by the vanity of increased dreams and words? How is the fear of God the remedy to this problem?
- 6. As a people who have been redeemed and brought near to God through Christ, is our approach to God to be any different than the original hearers of this text? Is it possible to be both confident (Heb. 10:19) and reverent (Heb. 12:28-29) before the Lord at the same time? How so?
