SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week, we come across one of the most familiar passages in all of scripture, more for pop culture reasons than anything else. But there is more to this text than what most would care to think about. The seasons of life change, and there is a time for all of it. This is an examination of God's sovereignty over all times and what that means for us. To many, it is a terrifying prospect to realize that we have so little control. But to those of us who fear him, our response should be different.

Discussion Questions

- 1. How are you feeling about this walk through the book of Ecclesiastes so far? Have you been encouraged or discouraged? Or a little of both?
- 2. The poem that is presented to us in the first eight verses presents us with numerous pairs of extremes. What is the overall observation of the poem?
- 3. When you examine the various things that the Preacher tells us there is a time for, what are some of the things listed that you struggle believing? Why do you think you struggle with these?
- 4. Read verse 11. What is this verse telling us and how does it have the potential to be so frustrating? Has there ever been a time in your life where you desperately wanted to know what God was doing?
- 5. How then should we live knowing the extent of God's control over everything that happens? Do you feel at peace with all of this?
- 6. How does knowing Jesus and his gospel give us a greater advantage to living the way we are called over the original audience of this book?
