# **SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

The second half of Ecclesiastes 7 proves to be one of the most difficult passages to understand up to this point and it's possible that this is exactly what the author intended. But he isn't attempting to be confusing for its own sake. The search for wisdom and understanding the way forward in life is a pursuit that is already immensely confusing and impossible to grasp. This is what the Preacher explores in this passage.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. In last week's passage the Preacher talked about the wisdom of recognizing God's providence in the midst of adversity. What makes us apprehensive to trust God's complete control when we, or people we love, are suffering?
- 2. In 7:15-18, we read that we are not to be overly righteous or overly wicked. What are we to make of this command? How ought we to live?
- 3. In verses 7:20-22, the Preacher points out that no one is truly righteous, including ourselves. Why is he talking about this here? How does this fit with the overall message of this passage?
- 4. In 7:23-24, we see that the Preacher expresses a frustration with the pursuit of greater wisdom and the understanding of things. What is it? Was there ever an instance or season of life where you related to the Preacher's frustration?
- 5. Starting at 7:25, we read about this pursuit to seek out the 'scheme of things'. What is meant by this? What conclusion does he come to at the end of chapter 7?
- 6. How does our understanding of the gospel give us greater clarity and hope in what the Preacher is getting at in this text?
