# SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this week's passage, the Preacher zeroes in on possessions and wealth. But it isn't the message that many of us might expect on the subject. The issue of having wealth or not isn't as much the concern of the Preacher as the approach to it and the heart of the one who has it. It is a message that ought to resonate well with us who have been given much in comparison to most throughout the world.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Last week, the Preacher gave the command to guard our steps when you go to the house of God. What does that mean and how can you practically grow in that area?
- 2. In the beginning of this passage, the Preacher tells us to 'not be amazed when we see oppression of the poor and the violation of justice and righteousness'. Why shouldn't we be amazed? What is he telling us in verses 8-9?
- 3. According to verses 10-17, what is the real danger of accumulating wealth? Is having wealth and possessions evil?
- 4. How is it possible to enjoy our possessions rightly? What does that actually look like?
- 5. In the last verse of this passage, the Preacher tells us that 'Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the appetite.' What does this mean? In what ways are you often led by your appetite?
- How has your transformation in Christ changed the way that you view your things and money? What are some things that Jesus said about this subject in the gospels?


