SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this penultimate sermon from our Ecclesiastes series we see the Preacher give instructions to remember and rejoice in this life. While this passage certainly applies to all who read it, he has something to say to young people in regards to how to approach the days of youth. The harsh reality is that we will all fade and die. Therefore, how we think about and spend our days matters.

Discussion Questions

1. According to last week's passage (11:1-6), what does it look like to work faithfully and wisely? What are some of the traps we fall into that prevent us from taking actions that we ought to?
2. 11:7-8 gives us some reminders about the nature of life. How are we supposed to approach the days that we are given and what should we expect?
3. What is the Preacher's advice for young people in 11:9-10? Why is he specifically speaking to the youth here?
4. The Preacher goes on in 12:1-7 to also tell us to remember our Creator before the troubles of old age and death come upon us. What is the advantage of knowing God from early on in life? How should we think about and approach this portion of the passage if we are older in years?
5. How might this passage shape the way we, as a congregation, think about our kids at Grace? How does this challenge you personally?
6. Even though there are many 'days of darkness' in this life, we are called to rejoice in the time God has given us and to remember him. How does knowing Christ give us an advantage in this regard that even the Preacher didn't fully understand?
