SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week, we look at a darker element of the Christmas story that significantly contrasts with the joyous elements of the holiday that we are familiar with. It's the story of Herod's plot to kill the child and God's divine intervention in guiding Joseph to Egypt and eventually Nazareth. This is more than an isolated event, Matthew cites Old Testament scripture to show us that something larger and of ancient days is at work in God's plan.

Discussion Questions

- 1. In the story from the passage last week (2:1-12), what do the varying responses of the characters involved in the birth of Jesus teach us about Christ? What do they teach us about our response to Christ?
- 2. At the angel's instruction, Joseph, Mary and the child flee to Egypt to escape Herod. Why is Jesus in Egypt so significant? How does the Old Testament inform our understanding of its significance?
- 3. In verse 16, we read of Herod's slaughtering of children. Why do you think Matthew chose to include this event in his gospel? How does including this dark moment in history affect our understanding of the Christmas story?
- 4. Matthew quotes Jeremiah 31:15 in regards to Herod's evil act. Take a broader look at all of Jeremiah 31. Knowing the context of this verse, what is Matthew saying by including it?
- 5. Jesus eventually ends up in Nazareth. What do we know about Galilee and Nazareth? Why is it significant that Jesus grew up there?
- 6. What does this passage tell us about the nature of God's saving work for us? What does it teach us about God's character?
