SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In the wilderness, Jesus accomplished what no man could by overcoming the temptation of the evil one. Now it is time to begin building his kingdom, but Christ's kingdom is very different from everything we have come to expect concerning power and reign. All of our expectations are gloriously reversed as we see what he has come to do.

Discussion Questions

- 1. For the Christmas Eve service, Pastor Mike preached from the story of Christ's temptation in the wilderness. In what way does Jesus overcoming temptation give us a fuller understanding of Christmas?
- 2. In 4:12-13, we see that Jesus begins his ministry in Capernaum. What makes this area significant? How does Jesus beginning in this region give us hope for today?
- Why does Jesus use the phrase 'I will make you fishers of men' when calling the disciples? What does it tell us about the nature of our calling as his servants in this world?
- What does it tell us about Jesus that he chose fishermen as his first servants? How does this encourage/challenge you?
- 5. In 4:23-25, we see a glimpse of what this kingdom is all about. What elements of Christ's kingdom are presented here? How is it different from all other kingdoms?
- What does this passage tell us about the gospel? How can we reflect on these things and grow in our passion for sharing the gospel with others?

ANNUAL MEMBER MEETING


Sunday, January 28th // 11am All members are encouraged to attend. While only members can vote, all are welcome to join in and hear what's happened and will be coming up at Grace Church in
