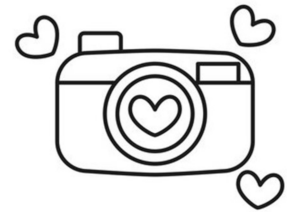


“God Filled the Seas with Fish” Take Home Page



Big Idea: God is sovereign over the seas and all that is in them.
His creativity extends to the wide diversity of sea life.

Memory Verse: “The LORD does whatever he pleases Him, in the heavens
and on the earth, in the seas and all their depths.” Psalm 135:6

At Home Activity: Watch and Marvel

Find a nature video to stream and watch with your preschooler that shows them some of the more unique aquatic life that God created. Talk about what you see together and how that shows God’s creativity, wisdom, and power.

At Home Activity: Calm the Seas Jar

In a mixing bowl combine clear glue and hot water (Ratio of 20% glue and 80% water) add some liquid food coloring for color and some glitter of your choice (chunky or fine glitter works). You can also add some tiny plastic fish if you wish. Mix with a whisk and then pour into a clean glass or plastic jar. (If some glitter is still stuck in your mixing bowl just add some more hot water to loosen it.). Put the lid on your jar and tighten. Shake up the jar and make sure the “calm down” effect is working as you want it to. If it’s not add more glitter or more glue or more water depending on what you need. Once it gets to where you want it, secure the lid with hot glue. Once cool give it to your child and have them watch. You may want to read the story of Jesus calming the sea (Mark 4:35-41). Remind them of this week’s Bible verse—Psalm 135:6.
