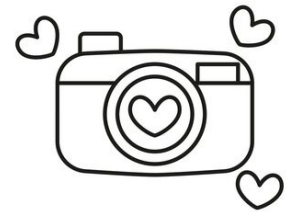


“God Filled the Skies with Birds”



Take Home Page

Big Idea: God provides for all the needs of all of His creation. Nothing is too hard for God.

Memory Verse: “Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?” Matthew 6:26

At Home Activity: Feed the Birds

Set up a bird feeder in your yard that can be seen from your window (or simply scatter some bird seed on the ground). Over the next several days spend time observing the birds that come to your yard. How do they eat? What kind of sounds do they make? What colors are they? Read Matthew 6:25-26 together. Do you have things that you are anxious or worried about? Is your heavenly Father able to care for you? Thank Jesus for what you discover.

At Home Activity: Bird Books

Find a book about birds from your local library or look up different kinds of birds online or find some videos about birds. Point out the differences in size and ability. Point out that some birds like the ostrich or the penguin can't fly. Did God make a mistake when he made those birds? No! God created the ostrich to have large, strong legs so that it could be a fast runner instead of a flying bird. God gave penguins special wings that act as paddles so that they could swim. God provides for all types of birds. How much more does He provide for us?
