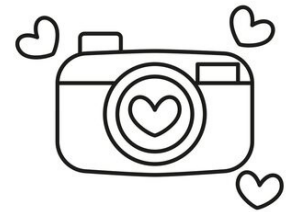


“God Created Livestock” Take Home Page



Big Idea: God created some animals to have a special relationship with people.

Memory Verse: “The LORD is good to all; He has compassion on all He has made.” Psalm 145:9

At Home Activity: Animals in Our House

Go through your house and find something made of wool, something made of leather or beef, something made with milk, etc. Talk with your child about where each of these items comes from and how God uses animals to provide for our needs. Review this week’s memory verse and point out that God is good to the animals and to us in creating things to work this way.

At Home Activity: At the Farm

Visit a local farm or petting zoo. Have a local farmer or zoo keeper tell you all about the various animals and what they can do. Talk about how you can touch some of these animals. Some of these animals you might even be able to ride. But would we reach out and pet a lion or a bear? No! God did not design those animals for that purpose but He did create some animals to have special relationships with people to help us do our work.
