SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week is unique, instead of the usual short scripture passage, we are studying the entire three chapters of the Sermon on the Mount this Sunday. While we will be taking time to examine it in more bite-size pieces in future Sundays, it is important to first look at it as a whole. What we discover, is the level of authority that Jesus holds and the heart of God in what he commands of His people.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What have you learned about Jesus over these last few months as we've gone through the beginning of Matthew together? Has your perspective on the Lord changed at all during this time? How so?
- 2. In verses 5:3-12, Jesus begins with the Beatitudes. What is it about these statements that makes them so stunning? What do they tell us about Jesus?
- 3. Read verses 5:17-18. What is Jesus making clear before he presses further into the sermon? Why is this especially important given what he teaches throughout the rest of chapter 5?
- 4. If you had to sum up in a sentence what Jesus teaches throughout chapter 6, what would that sentence be? In the things he speaks of in this chapter, where have you seen growth since becoming a Christian?
- 5. Jesus concludes this sermon in chapter 7 by differentiating between those who teach and follow his word and those who don't. What are the differences that you see? Does any one of these passages ever give you pause?
- 6. How is the Sermon on the Mount good news for those who love and follow Christ? Why is it important to not make the common mistake of seeing this sermon as a series of impossible commands that we are not actually intended to follow?

MISSIONS

Pray for the unreached.

Recently, 3 men from Grace Church travelled to Azerbaijan in Central Asia with our Grace missionary partner serving in this predominantly Muslim country. Of the 30 million Azerbaijanis in the world today, most live in Azerbaijan and to the south in Iran. Out of the 60,000 living in the U.S., there are only a few hundred known followers of Jesus. With only one percent Evangelical Christians among this people group, most Azerbaijanis will live and die without ever hearing the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ. But there is hope! In the last five years, thanks to God's sovereignty, the church in Azerbaijan has been multiplying through local believers and indigenous pastors.

- Pray for Azerbaijani believers to be bold in their faith and share the good news with other Azerbaijanis.
- Pray for more missionaries to go to these hard areas and proclaim the gospel, make disciples, plant churches and mentor new pastors.
- Pray for Azerbaijanis in the U.S. to meet devoted Christians who will share their faith and lead them to Jesus.
- Pray for Jesus to reveal Himself to Azerbaijanis through dreams and visions.
