SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

We have now reached the fifth beatitude which tells us that the merciful are the blessed ones. This is a unique beatitude amongst the list of others in that the outcome replicates the command. The merciful will be shown mercy. It is another insight into what citizens of the kingdom are to be like.

Discussion Questions

- 1. The beatitudes describe what citizens of the kingdom are like. How do you see each of the beatitudes so far exemplified in the life and ministry of Christ (the King)?
- 2. What does it mean to be merciful? What does it look like to put that into action?
- 3. Jesus tells us that the merciful will be shown mercy. Take some time to skim ahead in the pages of Matthew. What other places do we see Jesus teaching this same thing?
- 4. In what ways is being merciful different from being meek? Why is it important to make this distinction?
- 5. Think about a time where you were shown mercy from another Christian. How did it affect your faith in Christ?
- 6. How does our knowledge and faith of what Christ has done for us in the gospel give fuel to living out this beatitude? How eager would you say you are to show mercy to all who struggle?

Mr. & Mrs. W in North Africa have 2 young children and have been partnered with Grace Church for over 15 years. Serving in a North African country that is 99% Muslim creates many challenges to sharing the Gospel. Bibles are scarce and open evangelism is illegal. Social, family, and workplace persecution can turn violent. Yet, small churches are being planted and the Gospel continues to move forward.

Prayer requests:

- That the Lord will sustain them when sowing seeds on this very hard soil.
- That the Lord will protect the few small churches that exist from persecution.
