SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

We are now into the latter half of our Lord's beatitudes in which we are getting a clearer picture of the type of people who are part of his kingdom. In verse 8, Jesus calls us to purity of heart and promises the gift of seeing God. It is a simple statement, but holds profound weight that gives us a hope beyond anything before.

Discussion Questions

- 1. How were you challenged last week on the call to be merciful? What does that look like in your life practically?
- 2. What do you think of when you hear the word, *purity*? What does Jesus mean when he speaks of it here?
- 3. In what way is being pure of heart a part of the good or *blessed* life?
- 4. What does it mean to see God? How is it related to purity of heart?
- 5. Is there an example of someone you know who you're comfortable describing as pure in heart? How does their life demonstrate this?
- 6. How does the gospel drive our desire toward purity? How does this message speak to non-believers?

MISSIONS

PRAY FOR THE UNREACHED IN NORTH AFRICA: TUNISIAN ARABS

Tunisia, in North Africa, has a population of about 12.5 million. It is 99% Muslim and 0.03% Evangelical Christian (1 believer for every 3,100 persons!). Although the new constitution bans religious persecution, it also requires a Muslim president, and states that Islamic traditions and beliefs guide the government. Mosques and Imams (religious leaders) are paid by the government. Tunisian Christians can be highly persecuted by friends and family with physical violence and removal from the home and community. Evangelical churches are almost nonexistent with small house churches gathering mostly in secret. However, we know that just as in the days of early Jerusalem, our God is sovereign, and the gates of Hell shall not prevail against His church!

- Pray for Tunisian believers to be protected and be bold in their faith and share the good news.
- Pray for the Lord to raise up more missionaries to go to this land of hard soil.
- Pray for the 20,000 Tunisians in the U.S. to meet devoted Christians who will share their faith and lead them to Jesus.
- Pray for Jesus to reveal Himself to Tunisian Arabs through dreams and visions.
- Pray for the Tunisian president and members of the government to discover Jesus as their divine authority.
