SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this third beatitude, Jesus tells us that the blessed ones are people who are meek. It is a word that we sometimes use, but rarely think about what it means and what it actually looks like in day to day life. But it is a quality that our Lord holds at a high value and is connected to our inheritance as his people.

Discussion Questions

- 1. From the first two beatitudes that Jesus teaches, he says "blessed are the poor in spirit, blessed are those who mourn". What picture is starting to form about the people who populate his kingdom? How have you been encouraged/challenged over the last two weeks?
- 2. How is meekness properly defined? How is it different from weakness?
- 3. Back in Numbers 12, Moses is described as meek. Read Numbers 12 together and talk about what makes his interaction with Aaron and Miriam properly meek. In the life and ministry of Jesus, how does he demonstrate true meekness?
- 4. Jesus connects meekness with inheriting the earth. Why? What do the two have to do with one another?
- 5. In what areas of your life do you struggle with meekness? In what kind of situations do you trend toward defensiveness with others? What insecurities do you hold that resting in God's promises ought to put to death?
- 6. In what way does the outside world need to hear this as well? How does this teaching factor into the way we share the gospel with non-believers?
