# SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This Sunday concludes our time together in the Beatitudes and it ends with a word on the world's response to the righteous. Hostility and persecution are not just a probability, they are to be expected. And even though this is the reality for God's people, we are to rejoice because of what we already have reserved for us in heaven.

#### Discussion Questions

- 1. Reviewing last week's sermon, what does it mean to be a peacemaker? How can you personally grow in this?
- 2. Why does the world respond to righteousness with hostility? Why would the beatitudes be offensive to the world?
- 3. Both the *poor in spirit* and *those persecuted for righteousness sake* will inherit *the kingdom of heaven*. Why does Jesus connect these? What do they have to do with one another?
- 4. In verse 11, Jesus begins to address the crowds directly. Is he saying the same thing as in verse 10 or is he doing something different? Explain.
- 5. Why does Jesus bring up the prophets? What is he saying about himself by doing so? What is he saying about those who are persecuted by comparing them to the prophets?
- 6. How does our response to persecution reflect the gospel message? How does our ability to be joyful in persecution affect our witness?
