## SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This Sunday, we celebrate together the resurrection of our Lord as Holy Week and the Lenten season come to a close. Resurrection Sunday is the highest holy day in our calendar because if Jesus isn't raised from the dead, then we don't have a foundation for our faith. As we see in Psalm 16, not only has God raised him, but this was the plan all along.

### Discussion Questions

1. During this season of Lent, what has the Lord impressed upon your heart and where has he drawn your attention?
2. How does the first verse of Psalm 16 set the tone for the rest of it? What is the attitude of the author?
3. What is so striking about the way the writer is talking about God, particularly in verse 8? What does this tell us about the writer?
4. What is the writer teaching us about God and himself in verses 9–10? Why is this so important for us to understand as we celebrate Resurrection Sunday?
5. Read Acts 2:27-33. How does Peter teach this passage and use it to definitively state that it is written about Jesus?
6. How does knowing that Jesus was physically raised from the dead change everything in your life? How should it affect what you do daily and your relationships with others?

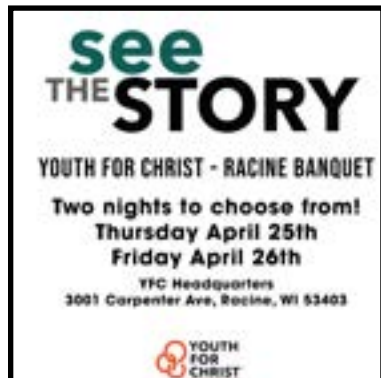
