SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In Matthew 6:11, we come to a short petition asking for God to give us our daily bread. And while this may be a familiar phrase to many of us, our regularity in praying this way might be lacking. In this verse, Jesus is teaching us something very important about God and the way that we daily interact with him.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: How does a desire for the kingdom to come affect the way we live our lives? Are their parts of your lives that you would say are not kingdom oriented?
- 2. Jesus calls us to petition God to give us this day our daily bread. What does this prayer mean? What does it tell us about God?
- 3. How much do you trust God's consistent provision for you? Why is it sometimes easier to trust the Lord with the really big things in life, but then we get anxious about the small things?
- 4. Read Deuteronomy 8:1-10. How does the situation with the Israelites in the wilderness compare to our situation as his new covenant people? Think about where they came from, how God sustained them, and where they were heading?
- 5. How can the message of God's provision speak to the heart of non-believers? How is the idea of truly being able to trust the Lord with all things (even the small stuff) an important component of the gospel message?
