SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In reflecting on a great week of VBS, we took a slight detour this Sunday from the Sermon on the Mount to look at the story of Elijah and the prophets of Baal from 1 Kings 18. It serves as a reminder that the Lord we worship really is the One True God.

Discussion Questions

- 1. This story begins with Elijah challenging the people of Israel to make a choice between the Lord and Baal. Why was Baal worship so enticing for the people of Israel at the time?
- 2. Who were the original recipients of 1 Kings? How does this help to bring some understanding as to why this story is important?
- 3. In what modern ways do we mimic the Isarelites in "limping between two different opinions" (vs. 21)? In other words, what does it look like when we engage with idols?
- 4. From the extreme ways that the false prophets plead to Baal, to God's response after Elijah's simple prayer, every detail of this contest is dramatic. Why would God do it this way instead of just wiping out the false prophets immediately? What is the significance of the way that God had this play out?
- 5. At the end, Elijah commands the people to seize the prophets of Baal and slaughter them. How are we, as God's people now, to think about this part of the story?
- 6. How does this story relate to the gospel message? What does it tell us about God, his grace, and his redemptive purposes?


MISSIONS PRAYER HOUR
