

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

After multiple weeks focusing on the Lord's Prayer, we now move onto the next part of the Sermon on the Mount. In <u>Matthew 6:19-24</u>, Jesus begins to teach on money and possessions. And although the way we view and spend money is not a popular idea to be confronted with, it is indicative of what our heart truly values.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: Last week we covered 6:13 where Jesus teaches on prayer concerning temptation and evil. How does knowing that we all are engaged in a spiritual battle shape your prayer life?
- 2. From a modern perspective, what does it look like to store up treasures on earth (6:19)? In what ways do you tend to fall into this?
- 3. What do you think *treasures in heaven* (6:20) actually are? Are they material or spiritual? Or are they some kind of combination of each?
- 4. What does Jesus mean by the eye being the *lamp of the body* (6:22)? What does it mean and look like to have a "healthy eye" vs. a "bad eye" (6:22-23)?
- 5. Jesus tells us that it is impossible to serve two masters in 6:24. Practically speaking, how is this true? Why do we often still fool ourselves and try?
- 6. Looking at your own life, would you say that everything you own is devoted to the Kingdom? How might the Lord be challenging you in regards to the stewardship of your money?
