SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

As we start to wrap up Jesus' teaching on how we treat others in the Sermon on the Mount, we come to another passage about prayer. But instead of teaching us how to pray, our Lord gives us a word about the confidence we ought to have when we pray. It is an encouraging word about the level of access we have to our loving father in heaven.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: According to last week's passage (7:1-6), what does it look like to judge/ discern righteously? Is this passage teaching that we are not to judge at all?
- 2. Jesus commands us in 7:7 to ask, seek, and knock. What is it that he is telling us to freely ask for?
- 3. Verse 8 tells us that *everyone who asks receives*. Is Jesus making an absolute statement about God's answering us when we pray in this way? Explain.
- 4. Why is it so important to understand this passage about prayer within the context of everything Jesus has taught up to this point in the Sermon on the Mount? Why is it so easy for people to take a passage like this out of context?
- 5. In 7:9-11, Jesus makes the case for God's willingness to answer us as a loving father. Do you come to the Lord in prayer with a confidence that he loves you and is willing to give you what you are asking for? What gets in the way of having this confidence?
- 6. Why is this teaching on prayer good news for the unbeliever?
