

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week, we shift from the personal nature of what our hearts are serving and depending on, to our interactions with those around us. As we consider the concept of judging whether someone else is right or wrong, Jesus had strong words for us to consider before engaging in casting that judgment on others.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Matthew 7:1 is often quoted from Scripture, both by believers and nonbelievers. What is the misconception that often is associated with this verse?
- 2. What reality does the warning in verse 2 warn the readers about?
- 3. How does the illustrative example Jesus gives challenge the readers about their interactions with other people?
- 4. Read Galatians 6:1. How does this verse contribute to, or agree with, our passage in Matthew 7?
- 5. In Matthew 7:6, the author begins communicating about appropriate discernment. Why do you think he leaves this for last?
- 6. In what areas of life do you struggle to exercise appropriate discernment or judgment?
- 7. Is there a certain person or group of people that you find challenging to engage with in a humble manner regarding differences or even sins that should be corrected?
