About the series art: *The Storm on the Sea of Galilee* by Rembrandt, 1633 The Storm on the Sea of Galilee is the only seascape ever painted by Rembrandt. It depicts Jesus calming the waves of the sea, saving the lives of the fourteen men aboard the vessel. Of these fourteen men, it is said Rembrandt included a self portrait of himself in the boat, next to Jesus and his twelve disciples. On March 18, 1990, the painting was stolen by thieves disguised as police officers. They broke into the Isabella Stewart Gardener Museum in Boston, Massachusetts, and stole this painting, along with twelve other works. The paintings have never been recovered, and it is considered the biggest art theft in history. The empty frames of the paintings still hang in their original location, waiting to be recovered.

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In last week's passage, we were given a taste of what it costs to follow Christ. This week, Matthew gives us a fuller view of who we are following. Through the three stories presented to us in this text, we see a display of power that separates Jesus from anyone or anything before him.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: What does genuine discipleship entail according to Jesus in Matthew 8:18-22?
- 2. Why does Jesus comment on the disciples "little faith" in 8:26? Didn't they do the right thing by going to Jesus about the storm?
- 3. What does the fear of the demons in 8:29-31 tell us about who Jesus is? Does the reaction of the demons surprise you at all?
- 4. How is the story in 9:1-8 different from every other story of miracles and healings that we have heard up to this point? What is the claim that Jesus is making and why is it so astonishingly unique?
- 5. Would you say that your view of Jesus is as high as what scriptures presents him? Does the way you follow him daily reflect this high view?
- 6. When we share the gospel with others, it's easy to only focus on the meek and mild Jesus. Why is it necessary that we also present his power to the world? How do we do that?


